

Host Christmas in 12 Days

- Day 1 Make sure your invitations are sent.
 Plan your meal and any holiday décor. Coordinate potluck dishes with guests.
 Declutter the main living areas.
- Day 2 Make a shopping list (things you can buy now and later should be separate).
 Shop for things you can buy ahead of time.
 Declutter your kitchen (including those counters).
- Day 3 Finish any holiday décor (don't forget items you need to make for the table).
 Run a duster over corners, ceilings, and light fixtures.
 Declutter the bathrooms.
- Day 4 Cook anything that can be made and frozen (pie crusts, cookie dough, etc).
 Clean out the inside of your refrigerator/freezer and wipe down.
- Day 5 Clean those guest rooms (if you are having overnight guests).
 Polish silver (if using).
 Give your kitchen cabinets a wipe down.
- Day 6 Iron any table linens and store so they won't get wrinkled again.
 Clean all of your carpet and rugs with your Bissell carpet cleaner.
- Day 7 Clean your oven, stove top, and microwave in preparation.
- Day 8 Clean upholstery if needed with your Bissell carpet cleaner.
 Give entry areas one last clean sweep.
- Day 9 Make your last trip to the grocery store and get everything you need.
 Give your dining area one last clean.
- Day 10 Dust all surfaces.
 Sweep, mop, and vacuum all floors.
 Bring in any folding tables/extra chairs.
- Day 11 Clean bathrooms.
 Start meal prep and set the tables.
 Clean kitchen counters.
- Day 12 Cook the meal.
 Do one last final sweep of living areas and shut doors to unused areas.
