## **PERSONAL RECORDS**

Full legal name, DOB, and SSN or Tax ID Number for you, your spouse, and your dependents (Tax ID Numbers can be pulled from: https://goo.gl/1PpnUo)

Last year's tax return and receipt from last year's tax preparation

## **ITEMIZED EXPENSE RECORDS**

**Homeowner Expenses:** 1098 Form (mortgage interest statement), real estate taxes paid, statement of property tax payable in tax year, Form 5695 energy-efficient upgrades, moving expenses (move must be work-related and more than 50 miles)

**Education Expenses:** 1098-T (tuition statement and itemized receipts of qualified educational expenses); 1098-E Form (student loan interest statement)

**Charitable Contributions:** Detailed list of donations—must have receipts for contributions over \$250 and a Form 1023 for vehicle donations.

**Self-Employment Expenses:** Records of business/home-office expenses, assets, pension plan contributions, health insurance payments, and estimated tax payments (state and federal) made this year.

Child and Dependent Care Expenses: Name, address, and Tax ID or SSN of the provider

Health Care Expenses: Records of medical and dental costs

Alimony Expenses: Provide ex-spouse's full name and SSN
